**Risk Management Training Opportunities**

**“Safeguarding God’s Children”** –Prevention of abuse of Children and Youth (“Children”)

This is the training required (since October, 2005), for licensing and for compliance with the Policies for the Protection of Children and Youth from Abuse. This training is available online. **“Safeguarding God’ People”** –Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Harassment of Adults (“People”)

This is the NEW (2009 version) training required for licensing and for compliance with the Risk Management Policy for the prevention of adult sexual misconduct. This training is offered to lay people as well as to clergy - **All clergy are required to complete this training by December 31, 2010.** “Safeguarding God’s People” is NOT available online.

Dr. Paula Gooder, our keynoter, will explore with us ***“Facing the Challenges of Ministry: Glory, Fragility and New Creation in 2 Corinthians”***. Paula is freelance writer and lecturer in Biblical Studies at Kings College and St. Mellitus College, London and at the University of Birmingham and Senior Research Scholar of the Queens’ Foundation, Birmingham. Her areas of research include the writings of Paul with a particular emphasis on 2 Corinthians and Mysticism, Biblical Interpretation and the Development of Ministry in the Early Church. She is the author of numerous books including *The Meaning is the Waiting: The Spirit of Advent*; *Searching for Meaning: An Introduction to Interpreting the New Testament*; *A Way through the Wilderness: God’s Help in a Time of Crisis*; and *This Risen Experience: The Spirit of Easter*. Paula is Canon Theologian of Birmingham and Guildford Cathedrals, a Reader in the Birmingham Diocese and member of General Synod, the Archbishops’ Faith and Order Advisory Group. She lives in Birmingham, England with her husband Peter and daughters Susie and Ruth.

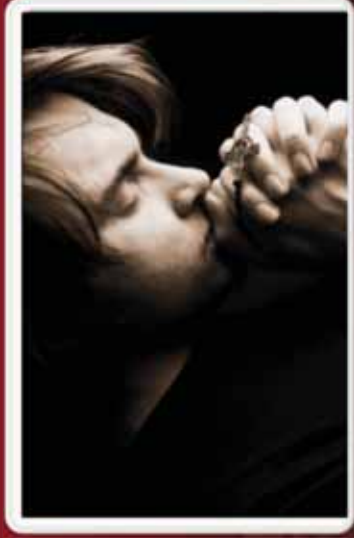

A. We praise God, not to obtain anything, but because God's Being draws praise from us.

Q. For what do we offer thanksgiving?

A. Thanksgiving is offered to God for all the blessings of this life, for our redemption, and for whatever draws us closer to God.

Q. What is prayer of oblation?

A. Oblation is an offering of ourselves, our lives and labors, in union with Christ, for the purposes of God.

Q. What is corporate worship?

A. In corporate worship, we unite ourselves with others to acknowledge the holiness of God, to hear God's Word, to offer prayer, and to celebrate the sacraments.
