The Fortieth Annual Convention of the Diocese of Central Florida will be held on Saturday, January 24, 2009, at Trinity Episcopal Preparatory School, 5700 Trinity Prep Lane, Winter Park, Florida 32792.

Clergy Conference – October 20-22



The Annual Clergy Conference will be held October 20-22 at Canterbury Retreat and Conference Center, 1601 Alafaya Trail, Oviedo. Our keynoter is The Reverend Dr. Christopher Seitz, Professor of Biblical Interpretation at Wycliffe College in Toronto, Ontario, Canada and "one of the foremost Old Testament scholars writing in English today." Dr. Seitz, whose brother The Reverend Tom Seitz is Rector of Church of the Good Shepherd in Lake Wales, was very well-received at the Clergy Day at Canterbury in April of this year. He is the author of numerous books including Zion's Final Destiny, Figured Out, Word Without End, Preaching and Teaching Isaiah, and Prophecy and Hermeneutics: toward a new introduction to the Prophets.

Registration begins at 3 p.m. on Monday. The Conference concludes after lunch on Wednesday.

Attendance at this Conference is mandatory – all parochial priests are expected to attend. Deacons are welcome as your circumstances permit.
